NSP Projects Supporting Russian NPP's


- More than US\$ 100 Mln allocated

INSP Projects Supporting Russian NPP's

Examples of achievements:

- Safety Parameter Display Systems installed at Kursk and Novovoronezh NPP's
- 12 Training Courses developed at Balakovo NPP and transferred to other sites
- RBMK Safety Maintenance Technology and Training provided
- Confinement Isolation Valves installed and Leak Tightness improved at Kola NPP
- EOI's Package developed and implemented at Novovoronezh NPP


Beneficiaries of Technical Assistance

Example: Novovoronezh NPP





Customs: Goals and Barriers

Customs related payments
(Simplified Formula):

$$P_{\text{total}} = P_{\text{tariff}} + P_{\text{VAT}} + P_{\text{paperwork}} + P_{\text{special}} + P_{\text{storage}}$$

P_{duty} – Customs Tariff Payment (15 %)

P_{VAT} - Value Added Tax (20 %)

$P_{\text{paperwork}}$ – Paperwork Processing Charge (0.1 %)

P_{special} - Special Tariff (3 %)

P_{storage} - Storage Related Payment

$$P_{\text{total}} > 35 \%$$
